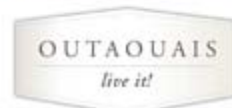

## OTTAWA!

[Parliament Hill](#) is the seat of Canada's federal government and the setting for historic and national celebrations. Highly photogenic when surrounded by fall foliage, the Hill is ablaze with colours during the [Christmas Lights Across Canada event](#), from early December through early January. Free daily tours include rides to the Peace Tower observation deck for spectacular 360° views of the capital.

[The Rideau Canal](#), Ontario's only UNESCO World Heritage Site, winds through the heart of downtown and is flanked by recreation pathways perfect for a relaxing fall stroll or bicycle excursion. In winter, the Canal freezes over to become the world's largest skating rink (7.8 km / 4.8 miles end-to-end) and the sparkling setting for February's [Winterlude](#) -- North America's greatest winter festival.



Ottawa is a great city at the edge of wilderness, with the beautiful and rugged [Gatineau Park](#) just a 10-minute drive from downtown. As the leaves turn colour each autumn, the Park hosts [Fall Rhapsody](#), welcoming hikers, cyclists and casual strollers for nature awareness programming. It's also a great time for scenic excursions aboard the historic [Hull-Chelsea-Wakefield Steam Train](#) through the Gatineau Hills. In winter, Gatineau Park is a cross-country skier's delight.

[The National War Memorial](#) is the solemn setting for the annual national Remembrance Day ceremonies each November 11, while the Peacekeeping Monument, [Supreme Court of Canada](#), international embassies, and [Rideau Hall](#) -home of Canada's Governor General-are all sights that you simply won't see anywhere else.

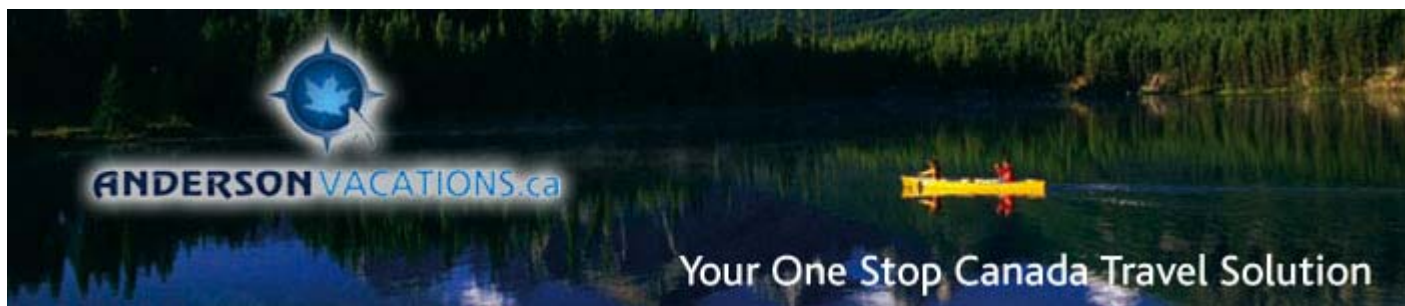
